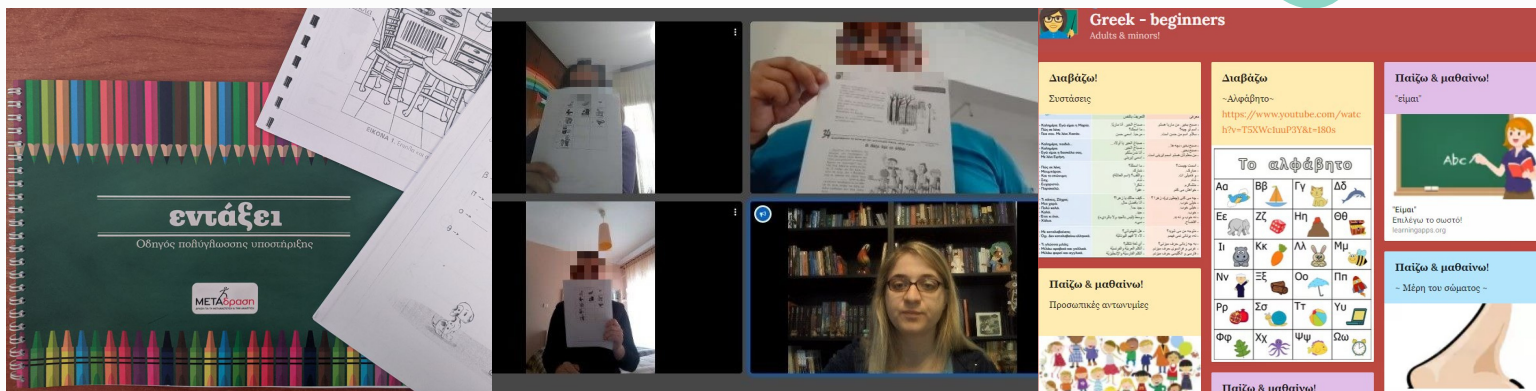

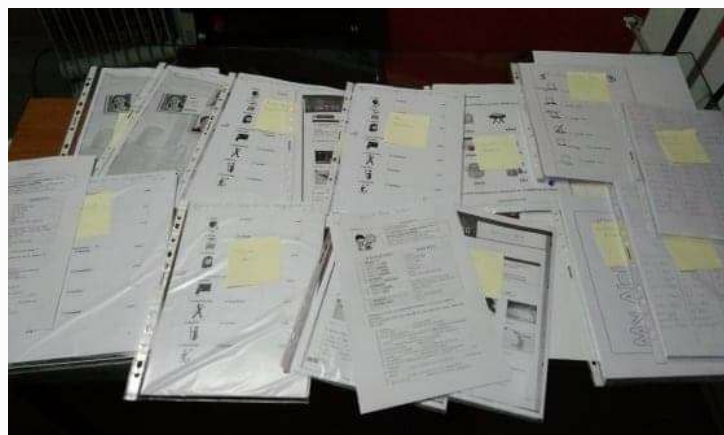
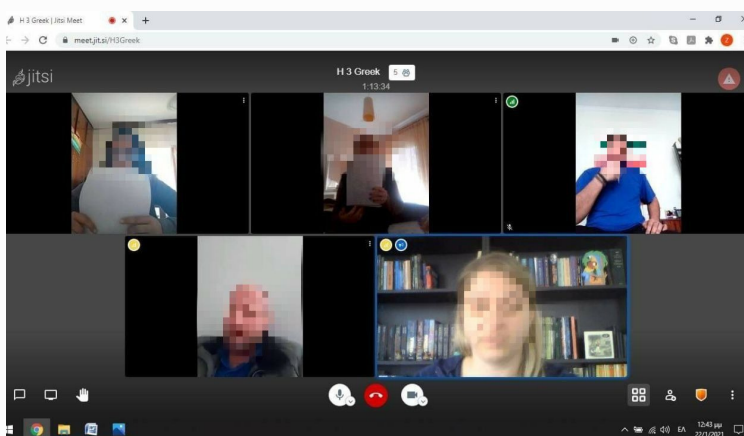


## ~Lessons~

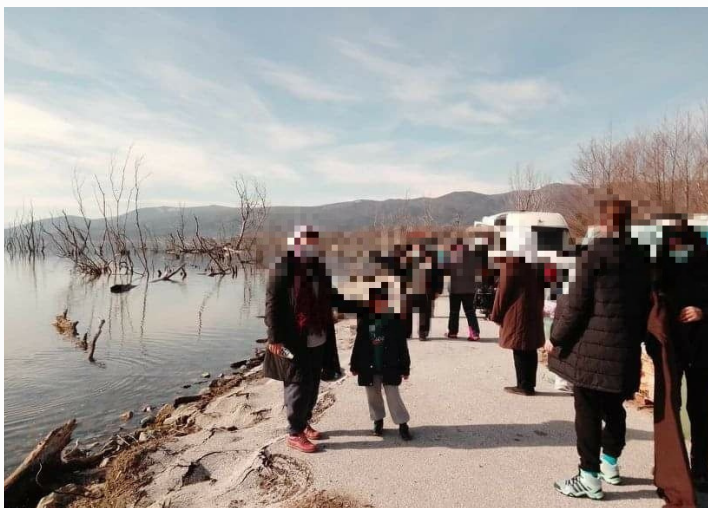


## ~Activities~

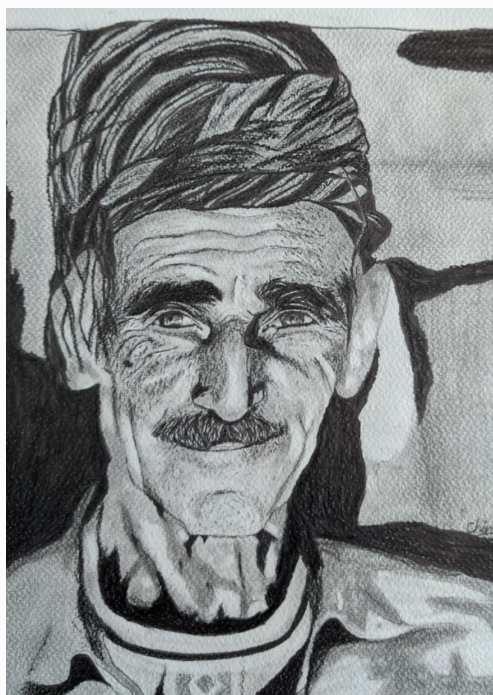
**When did you start painting?**

### Are you self-taught?

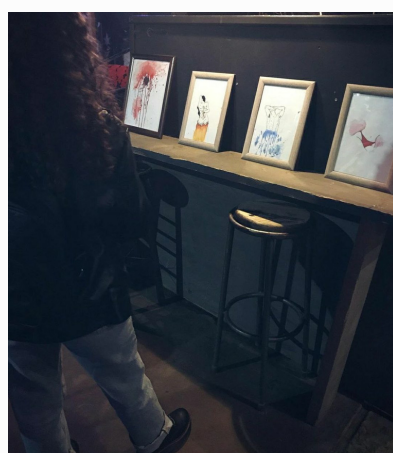
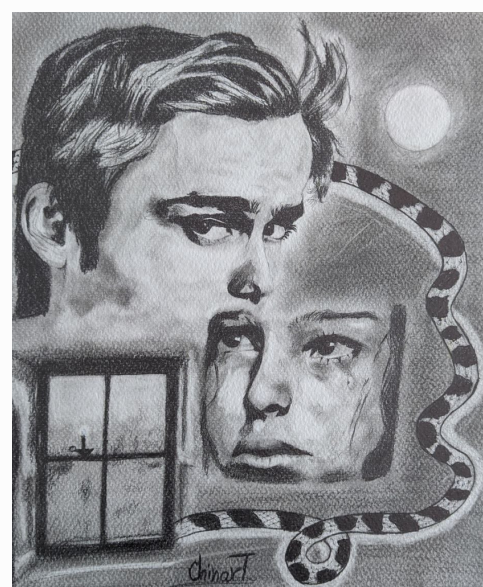
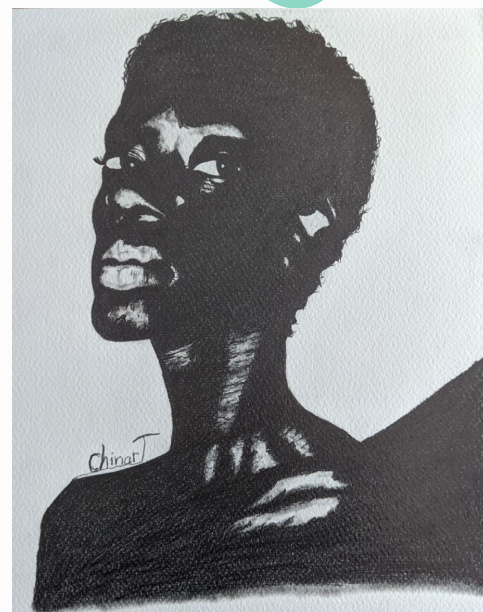
Yes, I have not taken any painting classes. I believe that I have inherited my father's talent, as well as other things!
