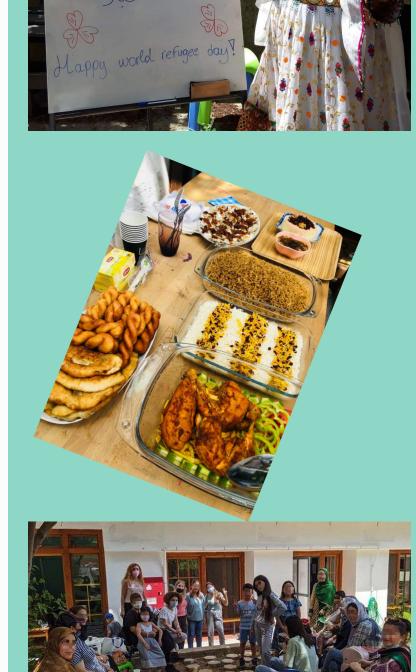
















INFORMATIVE MEETINGS – DISCUSSIONS
